The Private Sector Health Alliance of Nigeria (PSHAN) invites all eligible bidders for the renovation of selected Primary Healthcare Centres in Ikwerre, Obio-Akpor, Akuku Toru, and Emohua Local Government Areas of Rivers State – to amplify healthcare accessibility and quality for the local community.

The items include but are not limited to the construction of drains, roof, paving and landscaping, mechanical and electrical services installation, revitalization of wall, floor, and ceiling surfaces (fence, buildings, etc.), and the installation of signages.

  - b. Evidence of three similar completed projects.
  - c. Evidence of three projects completed within the localities mentioned.
  - d. 3-year audited account and tax clearance.
  - e. Evidence of financial capability supported by 6 months of company bank statements.
  - f. Affidavit on company integrity to demonstrate that none of the officials of the Intended State Ministry of Health, State Primary Health Care Management Board, and the Intended Local Government, is a director, shareholder, or has any fiduciary relationship with the company.

It is intended that part of the proceeds of these funds will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for Construction of Quality Bus Corridors Package 1, 2 & 3.
2. The Lagos Metropolitan Area Transport Authority (LAMATA), the implementing agency of LSTMPP for Lagos State Government now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Construction of Quality Bus Corridors Package 1, 2 & 3 ("The Works"). The packaging and work details are as follows:

8. Interested bidders must provide information evidencing that they are qualified, experienced and have adequate resources to perform the works. The following shall be evaluated to establish (A.) technical suitability of the technical proposal:
  - i. Preliminary Examination: (Verification of bid, Eligibility, Bid Security, Completeness.)
  - ii. Evaluation: General Construction experiences, Specific Experiences, Personnel, Equipment, Technical (Methodology, Traffic Management Plan, Work schedule, EHS), Financial (Minimum Average Annual turnover, cash flow, etc)
  - iii. Financial: Evaluated least cost of technically evaluated responsive bids
9. The three (3) packages (contracts) are independent of one another and bidder can express interest in more than one package. Where bidder expressed interest in more than one package, a letter indicating order of preference (ref to ITB 21 and Annex 3) must be submitted alongside the bid.

This Invitation for Bids is open to Construction Firms and the works shall be procured through International Procurement Competition. Least Cost method used with two stage and two envelopes approach (Technical and Financial (bid price) separately and distinctly packaged). The works is anticipated to start by Q1, 2024 and run over a period of 15 months

Interested bidders may form an Association or joint venture (JV) and relevant documents (agreement) duly signed by the participating firms must be included in the bid submission.
